

Report of the Provincial Grand Recorder

2022 Annual Meeting of the Provincial Grand Senatus of Surrey



Greetings Companions.

I'm pleased that since our last Annual Meeting things are slowly getting back to normal with Consistory meetings and visits to other Provinces.

Our Annual Meeting in August 2021 was not only the first meeting of Provincial Grand Senatus since our Provincial Grand Summus was appointed at a Virtual Business Meeting in July 2020, but it was also the first meeting of a Provincial Grand Senatus since the resumption of Masonic activity.

Joining us at the meeting was our Grand Summus, M.Dist.Comp. Ian S Currans, who was there to confirm our Provincial Grand Summus, R.Dist.Comp. In November, Warlingham Consistory confirmed the First Grade on four Candidates. This was followed in January with another two Candidates at Hill of Zion Consistory.

Some of these will be attending the meeting and will be presented to our Provincial Grand Summus, welcomed by him to their first meeting of Provincial Grand Senatus, and presented with a small gift.

Congratulations to R.Dist.Comp Trevor Currans who was reappointed as President of the Executive Committee, Very Distinguished Companion Ian Smith was reappointed for the third year as Grand Lecturer, Distinguished Companion Ian Clark received a first appointment to Past Grand Sword Bearer, and Distinguished Companion Len Hillier who received a first appointment to Past Grand Standard Bearer at the meeting of Grand Senatus in May.

The previous day at Mark Masons' Hall Dist.Comp. Alan Hall received his 5th Grade in the morning and, following a buffet lunch, Dist.Comps. John Norton-Doyle & Harry Smith received their 4th Grade. Congratulations also to these Companions.
